

Transportation in St. Louis

Concerned about getting from the Lambert Airport in St. Louis to the Renaissance St. Louis Grand and Suites for the AAM Advanced Attorney-Mediator Training and Annual Meeting?

There are several options available to you. Whether you are flying solo or bring a guest, or even the whole family. Take a look at the options below and enjoy your time in St. Louis!

Option #1

The *MetroLink light rail system* runs from the airport to the Convention Center Station, which is adjacent to the Renaissance St. Louis Grand and Suites. You can visit downtown attractions like Union Station, Riverboat Casinos and Busch Stadium with ease. The MetroLink light rail system fare is \$3.75 outbound from airport stations; \$2.25 elsewhere.

Option #2

GO BEST Express offers affordable, reliable and safe ground transportation services between St. Louis, Missouri Lambert International Airport and the Downtown St. Louis Hotels with economical shared ride van service leaving the airport every 15-30 minutes daily. There is van shuttle service departing Downtown St. Louis Hotels every 30 minutes to Lambert Airport. This shuttle service will cost you about \$18 one way from the airport.

Option #3

A *taxi* will be around \$30 one way. Travel time from the airport to the hotel is approximately 20 minutes
